In their "Care for Communities: Guidelines for National Red Cross Red Crescent Societies: A Community Health Systems Approach 2020," put out by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent, they mention <u>21</u> times that they have distributed contraceptives throughout the guide attached above.

In a chart on p.33, they list the following: "Detect pregnancy using pregnancy test and counsel on contraceptive or pregnancy options" and "Refer for family planning methods not available at community level such as longer-acting methods (injectables, implants, IUDs) and permanent methods (male and female sterilization)."
