NBCF compares seven breast cancer charities on their webpage, which include the American Cancer Society, which uses human embryonic stem cells in their research, and Susan G. Komen, who supports the same research and has had a relationship with Planned Parenthood. However, NBCF states the following:

Donating with confidence. No matter which of the above breast cancer charities you or your company select, you can be confident that you are making a good decision and one that can improve lives. If you choose to donate to a smaller, local organization, <u>do some research</u> ahead of time to ensure the organization aligns with your goals and values.

On their FAQ page, NBCF doesn't really condemn the use of oral contraceptives or mention how significant the linkage is between contraceptives and breast cancer:

**Is there a link between oral contraceptives and breast cancer?** There is an increased risk of breast cancer for women who have been using birth control pills for more than five years. However due to the low amount of hormones in birth control pills today, the risk is relatively small. But if a young woman has a significant family history of breast cancer, her gynecologist may recommend taking a break for a year from the pill at the 5-year time frame then resuming again for another 5 years. Although evidence-based research data does not offer strong support for this standard of care, it has nevertheless become an increasingly common practice. *Medically reviewed June 2023.*
