ABORTION & CONTRACEPTION

- Trevor Project's CEO releases the following [statement](#) on behalf of the organization, condemning the decision of Dobbs v. Jackson in June 2022:

"The Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization is causing many people to experience a wide range of concerns for bodily autonomy, LGBTQ rights, and public health, including mental health. The Trevor Project's polling has found that nearly 70% of LGBTQ young people say efforts to restrict access to abortion often gave them stress or anxiety.

Overturning Roe v. Wade will allow states to further restrict and regulate essential health care and reduce access to the already limited number of LGBTQ-competent providers in many parts of the country, posing a threat to the health and safety of young LGBTQ people. In undermining decades of jurisprudence on the constitutional right to privacy, this decision could also jeopardize the rights afforded to LGBTQ people in the landmark Obergefell and Lawrence decisions – to love who you love and be who you are without fear of criminalization.

The Trevor Project will not stop fighting to establish true, lived equality for LGBTQ people, and our counselors are here 24/7 to support all young LGBTQ people across the country who may be feeling a wide range of emotions – including fear, stress, and anxiety – in response to this decision."

- A January 2023 poll is [published](#) on the social and political policies that negatively impact the LGBTQ+ youth. It says 52% of LGBTQ+ youth find "efforts to restrict access to abortion" to give them "stress and anxiety."
- [Claims](#) that the creation of HHS' [Conscience and Religious Freedom](#) Division in the Office of Human Rights is formed to "discriminate" (archived):
"Those claiming a religious objection to providing services like mental health support to a young transgender person or an abortion to bisexual youth now have an office with the sole purpose of defending such harmful, discriminatory actions toward LGBTQ youth."

- [Advocates](#) for condoms and dental dams as a means of preventing HIV and AIDS.

LGBTQ+

- [Suggests](#) one can be an "ally" to transgender and nonbinary youth by "refraining from making assumptions about people's gender," "can't assume people's gender identities or names," and not "misgendering."
- Posts [videos](#) on social media advocating for transgenderism in children.
- Note: [The Trevor Project](#) promotes the LGBTQ+ lifestyle. It support transgenderism as well and promote stories of children and young adults who say they are transgender. It also advocates against parental rights to know the sexually explicit material being taught and read to their children in schools and libraries, and advocate against required notification to parents if their child wants to identify by a different name or gender in school.
